Fondazione Antonio Morra Greco (hereinafter "The Foundation") is looking for an International relation and internationalization activities support manager.

Deadline for application is May 28 2021, at 12 CEST.

- 2. The Foundation is now looking for a candidate to be enrolled as International relation and internationalization activities support manager.
- 3. Successful candidate will be offered a professional contract till December 2021. The final date of the contract is subject to extension based on the needs of the Foundation and/or the projects assigned to the International support manager.
- 4. The activities to carry out are: creating an international network of contemporary art institutions and their education departments; creating and managing a programme of online international activities (workshops, webinar, demonstrations, etc) on education topics, with the related communication materials; documenting all the activities of the international network; contributing to the creation of the EDI project platform by inserting all the documentation relating to the international network; identifying the needs of the international art community when it comes to digital platforms for education departments and developing the EDI platform to link regional, national, and international needs to increase and ensure its long term relevance in the field; supporting the development of an international forum to discuss best practices in art and education departments first online and then in person.
- 5. The above mentioned activities can be held on-line, while the candidate can be asked to come to Naples, at the premises of the Foundation, to carry out specific meetings and/or events.
- 6. The successful candidate:
 - Has a degree in topics related to Fine Arts, Communication or Education;
 - Has a proved professional experience in the topics listed at point 4 above;
 - Has a good command of English. Knowledge of Italian is an asset;
 - Is available to travel to Italy;
 - Is willing to work in an international environment, with relevant autonomy;
 - Is able to work in team.
- 7. This Call is mainly related to the following project: EDI 2021 Gloabl Forum on education, financed by European Funds, POR Campania FESR 2014/2020, POC 2021. However, the Foundation can enrol the successful candidate on other projects needing similar skills.
- 8. Candidates can apply by submitting their CV (personal history) at the <u>following link</u> (no later than May 28 2021, at 12 CEST).
- 9. Short-listed candidates will be interviewed to check their declared skills, their knowledge of English/Italian, their attitude to the position and their availability to travel. Interviews will be held in English. Candidates unable to take part into the interviews are excluded from the selection.
